1. Plan of action to improve student enrollment.

- Major IT & core companies in the state of Tamilnadu and number of employers, annual turnover, startup companies in native districts, cities.
- Higher studies opportunities, scholarship schemes of the State & Central Government may also be included.
- Conduct of young innovator contest for the +2 students in association with Core / IT companies
- Student Merit scholarships
- First graduate Scheme
- Sports person in National / State / District / Zonal level competitions.

2. Plan of action to improve placement ratio:

- Departments to tie up with the local companies to offer internship, inplant training and employment.
- Departments to tie up with the local companies to offer value added courses to suit the company needs.
- Objective type questions on aptitude / technical competency should be conducted every semester. (middle of the semester, before last working day.
- Conceptual Learning through NPTEL/ IIT Spoken Tutorial must be encouraged in all the department.
- British English course may be organized for First year students. Toppers may be rewarded suitably

3. Plan of action to improve internship ratio:

- Students with 7.5 and above CGPA may be permitted for internship after 7th semester.
- Every student should undergo industrial visit & in-plant training in second & third year summer /winter holidays and should submit a report to the department.
- A mini project may be submitted at the end of 6th semester / departments can organize a mini project Contest. Selected mini projects may be submitted to IPC to improve the project concepts.

4. EDC cell:

• Roles and responsibilities may be suitably framed and road map may be formed. The responsibilities include arranging for industrial visit, in-plant training, internship, expert talk, etc.,

5. Plan of action to improve industry connectivity and its importance:

- Colleges to tie up with the local companies to offer internship, inplant training and employment.
- Colleges to tie up with the local companies to offer value added courses to suit the company needs

6. Plan of action to improve the Patent registration and its importance:

- Awareness meeting on patents registration and its importance industry participation, monitory benefits.
- Ph.D. Thesis submission should include patent registration.
- Selected M.E. Thesis may be registered for patent.
- Selected B.E. Projects may be registered for patent.
- Every professor should file a patent.
- Journal publications and Ph.D completion may be rewarded suitably.

7. Plan of action to improve the GATE exam enrollment:

- Awareness on GATE examination and its opportunities.
- Time table to include slot for GATE preparation.
- Semester wise objective type questions on Engineering subjects.
- Intensive GATE coaching classes by experts during third & final year winter / summer holidays followed by week days.
- GATE scorers may be rewarded suitably.

8. Plan of action to improve the Ph.D registration:

- Ph.D registration to be made mandatory for all faculty within five years after joining the institution.
- Existing faculty, non registered, if any, to be made as compulsory.

9. Plan of action to improve the First year pass percentage:

- Admission process should be completed so as to start the First semester classes from the 1st week of July
 every year.
- Orientation programme as per the Regulation should be conducted for two weeks, without disturbing the academic schedule.
- Regular classes should be started during 3rd week of July, excluding the working days of orientation Programmes.
- Faculty members should train the students to attend Part-C. Also quality question banks must be prepared
 based on AU previous year question papers and should be given to the students.

10. Other Points

- Journal / Conference publication may include SCI and non SCI, National / Conference publications.
- CO to PO attainment calculation process may be standardized
- Research / Consultancy works must be taken up by the departments.
- All the academic support units must submit the report to IQAC every semester.
- File audit will be organized by IQAC
